

Birmingham and Frankfurt became formal partner cities in 1966. This year marks 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our partnership and a number of events have been planned jointly with the City of Frankfurt, Goethe Institute London and Frankfurt based organisations to celebrate it.

The anniversary programme has been designed to highlight existing areas of collaboration between the two cities, such as the Frankfurt Christmas Market and the partnership between the University of Birmingham and the Goethe University. Birmingham City Council is also working with partners to capitalise upon the anniversary to instigate new forms of co-operation. The programme ranges from civic events to business meetings and academic conferences as well as art and public involvement projects.
